

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

These instructions should be read carefully and retained after installation for further reference and maintenance

SAFETY


- 1. Before installation, maintenance or lamp replacement, ensure that the mains supply to the luminaire is switched off and the circuit supply fuses are removed or circuit breaker turned off.
- 2. It is recommended that a qualified electrician is consulted or used for the installation of this luminaire and installed to the current edition of the electrical and building regulations.
- 3. Check that the total load on the circuit including when this luminaire is installed does not exceed the rating of the circuit cable, fuse or circuit breaker.
- 4. This luminaire is suitable for indoor use in dry locations

RATINGS

- 1. ETL Approved for Canada and the USA
- 2. 120V 60HZ AC rated
- 3. Suitable for interior use under shelves, in cabinets and bookcases.

SCREW HOLE INSTALLATION FOR WOOD SHELVES

- 1. Remove fixture from package and remove screw kit from cord
- 2. Fixing holes must be clear of any obstructions (e.g. cables) within the mounting surface.
- 3. Use the fitting as a template to determine the desired spacing.
- 4. Mark the screw holes using the fitting as a template; you may need to rotate the lamp housing to expose the keyhole mounting slots.
- 5. Fittings may be daisy chained (8 LUMINAIRE MAX) using a connecting cable (sold separately)
- 6. If the luminaire is to be used singularly or is the first in the circuit of a multiple installation (daisy chain) then use the mains lead provided fitted with a mains plug.
- 7. If multiple installations (daisy chaining) ensure that the safety cover of the last luminaire is closed.
- 8. The lamp can be removed by pulling down on the diffuser and remove. Turn the lamp through 90 degrees and remove.
- 9. The reverse operation of the above should be applied to replace the lamp and diffuser.



MAGNET INSTALLATION FOR METAL SHELVES

- 1. Remove fixture from package
- 2. Ensure the metal shelving is clean, dry and free of debris
- 3. Position luminaire in desire position on shelf and allow magnet to take hold.
- 4. Fittings may be daisy chained (8 LUMINAIRE MAX) using a connecting cable (sold separately)

- 5. If the fitting is to be used singularly or is the first in the circuit of a multiple installation (daisy chaining) then use the mains lead provided fitted with a mains plug.
- 6. If multiple installations (daisy chaining) ensure that the safety cover of the last luminaire is closed.
- 7. The lamp can be removed by pulling down on the diffuser and remove. Turn the lamp through 90 degrees and remove.
- 8. The reverse operation of the above should be applied to replace the lamp and diffuser.



NOTICE for Magnetic version: The light is installed in top & level of furniture(Fig3). other degree is not allowed
